• FNCCI Operation Relief


- More than 25 organizations in OR with 22 Civil society leaders NAS, REDCROSS, KARUNA & many...

250 international rescue & emergency personnel deployed everyday

*Personnel were from the Stanford University Emergency Dept., Harvard University Disaster & Emergency Dept., South African Rescue Mission, Turkish Rescue Mission and the Japanese Rescue Team. Over Whelming support from Civil Society made it easier for Hospitals to run smoothly

- DELEGATE to EXPERTS
- AUDIO VISUAL TEACHING aids are very HELPFUL

BIGGER CONCERNS

- Untrained manpower for rescue
 - Could have avoided casualties
- Proper Orientation for Disaster Preparedness
 - could save lives
- Emergency KIT should be stored
- Auto evolving Model of Relief Camps
- KEY information centers could avoid duplication
- Authorized HELP DESKS at Airport could manage International Teams better
